**Note: Under Article C, Section II, of the Articles of Incorporation for the Eng Family Benevolent Association, the Association is prohibited from participating and influencing any political campaign on behalf of a candidate for public office. The following is an advisement to members who have questions, not an endorsement by the Association.**

City of Monterey Councilman **Mike Eng** has asked members of the Next Generation Group for their help in the final days of his campaign for a seat on the California State Assembly, 49th District. The area covers the cities of Alhambra, El Monte, South El Monte, Monterey Park, Rosemead, San Gabriel and San Marino. Mike is asking for volunteers to walk the neighborhoods and work the phone banks during certain hours from Saturday, June 3, to Tuesday, June 6, Election Day. ■ As stated above in the introduction, the Articles of Incorporation for the Eng Family Benevolent Association prohibited the organization from participating and influencing any political

campaign on behalf of a candidate for public office but it does not prevent members from volunteering as individuals or from soliciting other members of the organization individually, provided it is not using Association funds or forum to do so. ■ The Internal Revenue Code prohibits intervention in political campaigns by organizations, including religious organizations, as a condition for exemption from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. The Eng Family Benevolent Association, which the NGG group is part, exists as a corporation under IRS Section 501(c)(7), which applies to Social and Recreational Clubs (IRS Publication 557, pages 49-50). According to the IRS guidelines, political activities are not prohibited or restricted. The condition under Article C was established by the founding members of the Association. ■ NNG members are encouraged to exercise their individual rights in the democratic election process and if they are interested in finding out more about candidate Mike Eng to help their decision of support, please visit [www.mikeforassembly.com](http://www.mikeforassembly.com).
